ALCONA COUNTY LIBRARY OPERATING POLICY AND PROCEDURES

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

Any person will be asked to leave the library if any of the following incidents occur:

- 1. Viewing of child pornography
- 2. Viewing materials that are harmful to minors
- 3. Dressing in an obscene manner
- 4. Making noises that are disruptive to other patrons.
- 5. Harassment, physical or verbal abuse of staff or another patron.

The library staff will respond to all noise complaints. The library staff will call police if it appears that a crime has been committed.

If a person is asked to leave the library, that person is banned from the library for one week. If the person is a minor a letter from the Director will be sent to the parent stating our policy, the offense and the remedy.

Upon a third offense within a period of 1 year the person will be banned from all library use until a successful petition before the Library Board of Trustees.
